- (1) A plat and/or plot plan showing the exact location of the improvements/activities proposed.
(2) For construction projects, drawings showing all structural components and the type, dimensions and spacing of materials to be used, including railings, pilings, and elevations. NOTE THAT A BUILDING PERMIT WILL ALSO BE NEEDED.
Prohibited construction materials:
(a) Creosote-treated wood.
(b) Wood treated with arsenic (CCA), except that wood treated with CCA may be used for pilings, provided that (i) the pilings are treated in accordance with "Best Management Practices for the Use of Treated Wood in Aquatic Environments ("BMPs") as published by the Western Wood Preservers Institute, USA version, and (ii) a certification signed by the wood treater that all BMPs were followed is submitted to the City prior to any pilings being placed in the lake. (Note: A copy of the BMPs may be found at http://www.wwpinstitute.org/pdffiles/bmpsinaquatic2.pdf.)
(3) For dredging activities, a description of the methods proposed for removing, containing, storing, placing and/or disposing of dredged materials. If dredged materials are proposed to be placed on lands within the Cross Lake watershed, an erosion control plan must be submitted detailing the measures to be used to prevent the dredged materials from washing or eroding into the lake. (Note that dredged materials cannot be placed below the 172 foot contour line.)
(4) For vegetation removal projects, a description of the vegetation to be removed.
(5) For demolition projects, a description of the demolition/removal work to be performed and the destination of all materials to be removed/demolished. (Note that all demolished/removed materials must be properly disposed of in accordance with all applicable regulations. No debris may be disposed below the 172 foot contour line. If possible, pilings must be completely extracted from the lake bed. If complete extraction is not possible, pilings must be cut off at lake floor level and removed. Demolition/removal shall be performed in such a manner as to prevent, or minimize to the greatest extent practicable, leaching of preservatives during the demolition/removal process.)

**CERTIFICATION:**

I hereby certify that the above information is true and correct; that I am the legal owner of the property located at the address indicated above; that all improvements proposed to be constructed will comply with all building restrictions and covenants applicable to said address; that all improvements will be constructed according to construction specifications herein submitted; and that the improvements will be maintained in a safe condition at all times and will be subject to the inspection of the Shreveport Police Cross Lake Patrol and/or Department of Operational Services at any time. I do hereby covenant and agree that, for and in consideration of issuance of this permit, I will indemnify and hold harmless the City of Shreveport, its agents, and employees for any and all claims, demands, suits and judgments to any party for injuries and/or damages arising out of the activities proposed herein and/or the condition, maintenance, repair and/or removal of any constructed improvements. I also acknowledge that a Building Permit must also be obtained from the City of Shreveport for any improvements, after issuance of this permit.
